QSP/QSD Construction General Permit Training

California has adopted a new General Permit for Stormwater discharges associated with Construction and Land Disturbance Activities (Order No. 2009-0009- DWQ, NPDES No CAS000002). Effective July 1, 2010 this permit affects how your projects are designed, implemented, maintained, monitored, and reported. Join us for a clear, concise and informative session on the significant changes brought about by the new permit. This State Approved course is taught by experienced professionals who are certified "Trainer of Record" from CASQA and currently working in the field for Caltrans, City, County and local Agencies on NPDES, SWPPP, WQMP and related water quality issues.

California's construction stormwater general permit (CGP) requires that developers of construction Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plans (SWPPPs) (known as Qualified Storm Water Developers or QSDs) and those who will implement SWPPPs as practitioners (QSPs) demonstrate the skills, knowledge and experience necessary to perform this work. In addition, the CGP requires that individuals in these positions complete a State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) approved or sponsored training course within two years of the CGP adoption (September 2, 2011).

QSP TRAINING AS REQUIRED BY THE 2009 CGP

COURSE DESCRIPTION

16 Hour Course

This course curriculum will provide an in-depth review of the information individuals planning to become construction QSPs (prerequisite to the QSD) will be expected to know. It will provide an in-depth review of information concerning the CGP. This course consists of 5 modules: Training Overview and Regulations, Erosion Processes and Sediment Control, SWPPP Implementation, Monitoring, and Reporting.

The CGP also requires that a QSP be a Certified Erosion, Sediment and Storm Water Inspector (CESSWI) or a Certified Inspector Sediment and Erosion Control (CISEC) by September 2, 2011. *We can provide exam prep courses to assist with this requirement!*

QSD TRAINING AS REQUIRED BY THE 2009 CGP

COURSE DESCRIPTION

(includes QSP 16 hours plus additional 8 hours)

24 Hour Course

This course curriculum includes all QSP training as noted above and will provide an in-depth review of the information individuals planning to become construction QSDs will be expected to know and information concerning the CGP. This course consists of 3 modules: Project Planning and Site Assessment, SWPPP Development and Permit Registration Documents (PRDs) and Project Closeout.

Anyone can attend this training, but the CGP states that to qualify to take the State Water Board Exam, a potential QSD must be a registered civil engineer, geologist, landscape architect, hydrologist, professional in erosion and sediment control (CPESC), certified professional in storm water quality (CPSWQ), certified professional in erosion and sediment control registered through (NICET) *We can provide exam prep courses to assist with CPESC and CPSWQ!*
