The CGP identifies a set of prerequisite qualifications that would demonstrate the skills, knowledge and experience necessary to prepare and/or implement SWPPPs. In addition, the CGP requires that individuals in these positions complete a State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) approved or sponsored training course within two years of the CGP adoption (September 2, 2011).

This course curriculum will provide an in-depth review of the information individuals planning to become construction QSDs will be expected to know. It will provide an in-depth review of information concerning the CGP. This course consists of 3 modules: Project Planning and Site Assessment, SWPPP Development and Permit Registration Documents (PRDs) and Project Closeout.
